## swells and extensions

*Third floor exhibition space*

In *swells and extensions*, New York City artist Sharon Louden continues her explorations that come from a linear progression of drawings and previous installations where line and simple material are manipulated into form with a personality of its own. “Swells” glow from below and within the new piece, while “extensions” crawl across the floor, intermingling and surrounding the “swells” as an energy that is fast and contrasting. The twist lies in the dual nature of the monofilament material: with the lights on, shadows are drawn, with the lights off, a beautiful phosphorescence creates a feeling of landscape and “swelling” within the forms.
